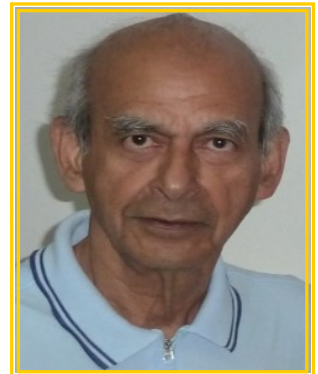

Faculty Profile: With a Ph.D. in Nuclear Engineering from the University of Florida, Gainesville, in 1970, Indian-born **Dr. Kesavan (Kesi) Nair** worked as a Professor and Researcher in Brazil. During this time, Dr. Nair also pursued his passion for astrology and integrative medicine, learning Jyotish (Vedic Astrology), with guidance from several noted astrologers in India (Kerala), and developed his own Vedic Astrology software (JATAKA). Since 1984, he has practiced Jyotish professionally, and since 1992, has led basic and advanced courses and seminars on the subject to Brazilian students. In addition, Dr. Nair has practiced Homeopathy (and other alternative therapeutic methods) for over 25 years. As Taksha Lecturer on Jyotish and Integrative Medicine, Dr. Nair will teach this introductory course for the first time in the USA, using his software.
